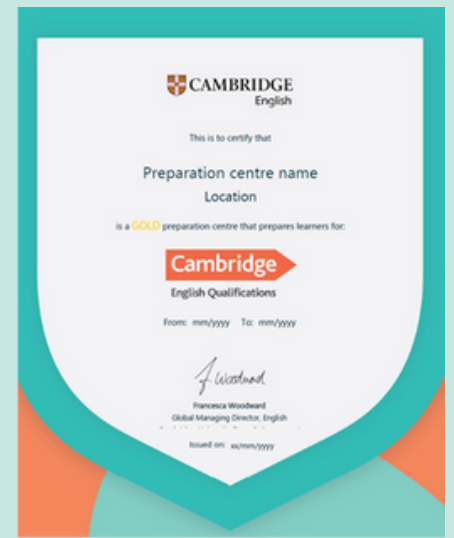

Schools and institutions should choose a Cambridge English Authorized Exam Centre to work with by reviewing the 'Find an Exam Centre' page within the Cambridge English website (<https://www.cambridgeenglish.org/find-a-centre/find-an-exam-centre/>).

Then they should contact the chosen Exam Centre to express interest in sending students to take Cambridge English exams at that Exam Centre. The Exam Centre will follow-up to explain the process.

Activation Email

Schools and institutions that are newly registered as Preparation Centres under the Exam Centre will receive an Activation Email from the Exam Centre. The email address given by the School/Institution's contact person should be the recipient of the Activation Email. This contact person should check his or her email Inbox (or Spam folder if the School/Institution did not receive the Activation Email) to click on the Activation Link within 21 days or the Activation Link will expire and a new Activation Email must be sent again by the Exam Centre.

Preparation Centre ID

The Exam Centre will send a Cambridge English Preparation Centre ID to the newly registered School/Institution which is the unique ID number for that School/Institution; the School/Institution should keep this Preparation Centre ID for future reference.

Candidate Registration

The Exam Centre will add the Preparation Centre details (e.g. school name) when the Exam Centre registers students from the School/Institution who take a Cambridge English exam at that Exam Centre. The count of these students will be used to recognize the School/Institution for the Preparation Centre & Educational Partners Programme within that Cambridge Financial Year.

How does a School or Institution Become an Educational Partner?

How does a school or institution become an Educational Partner?

Schools and institutions should first choose a Cambridge English Authorized Exam Centre to work with by reviewing the Find an Exam Centre page within the Cambridge English website (<https://www.cambridgeenglish.org/find-a-centre/find-an-exam-centre/>).

Then they should contact the chosen Exam Centre to express interest in sending students to take Cambridge English exams at that Exam Centre, and also express interest in becoming a Cambridge English Educational Partner. The Exam Centre will follow-up to explain the criteria for Educational Partners and explain the process to apply for it, if the school or institution can achieve the criteria.

What are the requirements to be a Cambridge English Educational Partner?

- Sign the Educational Partner Agreement
- Adoption of Cambridge English learning materials across School Year or Language Programme + Bronze level minimum entries
OR
- Gold level minimum entries with at least 25% of all entries using Computer-based exams + All English teachers complete Continuous Professional Development (CPD) eLearnings on CI LMS
- Recognition of Cambridge English Qualifications (use, recruitment, admissions)
- Teachers certified with Cambridge Teaching Qualifications (TKT, CELTA, DELTA, former CELT-P/S)

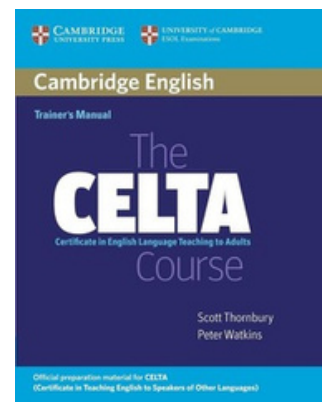
CELTA

A tour of the digital exam. For each level, a tutorial video will walk you and your students through the exam, so everyone understands how the questions are presented, how the digital features work and what's expected of candidates at each step.

- CELTA from Cambridge is a qualification for teaching English as a foreign language. It is the most widely recognised English teaching qualification in the world and the most often requested by employers.
- Focuses on developing practical techniques to give you the confidence to begin teaching
- Options for face-to-face, online or a combination of both depending on your individual needs
- Choose to take the course full time, usually 4-5 weeks, or part time over the course of a few months to a year

Teaching Knowledge Test

The Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT) is a series of modular teaching qualifications, which test your knowledge in specific areas of English language teaching. Whether you are a new teacher or have years of experience, TKT is ideal for people who need to prove their teaching knowledge with a globally recognised certificate.

The core modules are designed to provide a foundation in the principles and practice of English language teaching:

- TKT: Module 1 – Language and background to language learning and teaching
- TKT Module 2 – Lesson planning and use of resources for language teaching
- TKT Module 3 – Managing the teaching and learning process

There are further specialist modules, which can be taken separately or added to the core modules:

- TKT: CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning)
- TKE: Young Learners (YL)

You can take as many modules as you like, over any time period. You receive a Cambridge English certificate for each module you complete.

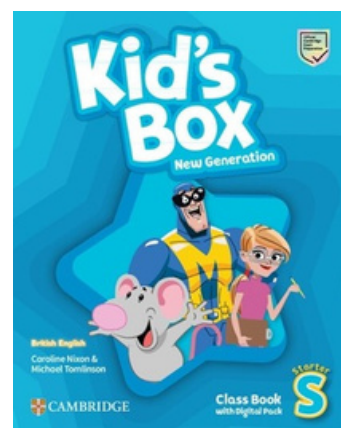

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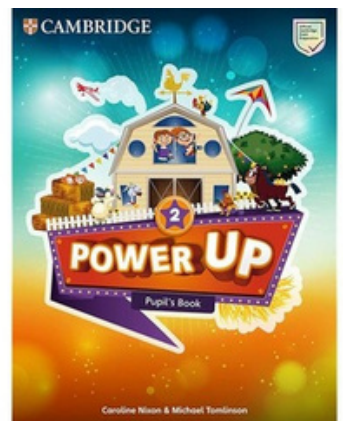

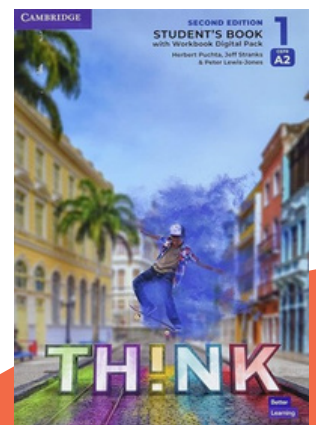

Opportunities for Study and Work at Home or Abroad

The information below shows some examples of the acceptance and usage of our qualifications and tests around the world. The proficiency requirements of individual institutions, organisations and departments may vary. We recommend that candidates contact individual institutions and organisations directly for more detailed information on their specific requirements.

For Visa or Study Applications

- **Australia:** The Australian Department of Home Affairs accepts C1 Advanced (paper-based version) for visas and migration.
- **Canada:** International students need to obtain a Study Permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). These permits are only issued to applicants who have been accepted into a university, college or private school recognised by the Canadian Government. Each institution sets its own admission requirements, including proof of English proficiency. Therefore, recognised Cambridge English Qualifications can be used for university admissions and for study visa permits.
- **Malaysia:** The Ministry of Higher Education accepts Cambridge English Qualifications and Linguaskill for international student admissions into Higher Education Programmes.
- **New Zealand:** Immigration New Zealand recognises B2 First and B2 First for Schools for all visa programmes that require proof of English proficiency.
- **Singapore:** The Ministry of Education recognises A2 Key for Schools and B1 Preliminary for Schools for international student admissions into primary school programmes in the Admissions Exercise for International Students.
- **United Kingdom:** Higher education institutions, which are visa Licensed Sponsors, can choose how to assess a student's English language proficiency for courses at degree level and above. This means that recognised qualifications such as C1 Advanced and C2 Proficiency, and increasingly B2 First can be used for both admissions and student visa purposes.

- Australia and New Zealand: Almost 100% of universities in Australia and New Zealand recognise C1 Advanced for undergraduate programs
- Japan: Top universities in Japan use Cambridge English Qualifications, including C1 Advanced, for admissions into various programmes.
